1.	The President negotiates a nuclear arms deal with Korea.
2.	The US government gives emergency aid to tornado victims in Charlotte, NC.
3.	The police catch and arrest three people suspected of robbing a bank.
4.	Congress passes a law setting up special courts to handle disputes over who has the right to make a certain product.
5.	The President asks Congress for money to build 100 additional stealth bombers.
6.	Congress sets aside \$10 billion to clean up toxic waste dumps.
7.	The first amendment was added to the Constitution in 1791. It protects citizen's rights to freedom of speech, religion, press, assembly, and petition.
8.	The government passes a bill that gives more money to cities to hire more police officers.
9.	Congress passes a law saying that no state can stop a US citizen from freely from one state to another.
10.	Congress passes a law that provides for the building of housing for elderly and disabled persons.
11.	The federal government grants a political party permission to hold a demonstration in Washington, D.C.
12.	Two neighbors go to court to settle a dispute over the boundary between their properties.
13.	Congress passes a law saying no tax can be placed on products that are shipped from one state to another.
14.	In 1937, Congress passed a law providing for the creation of the Social Security System to provide monetary assistance to the elderly.
15.	Congress passed a law which stated that public schools must provide athletic programs for both males and females.
16.	During the 1950's, Congress passed a law providing funds for the building of an Interstate Highway system throughout the nation.
17.	Congress decides to provide more funds for the FBI's "War on Crime."
18.	No state can pass a law that only applies to citizens from other states who are traveling in their state.
19.	A federal court orders a chemical company to make payments to workers who were injured in a spill.
20.	The government pays unemployment benefits to workers who lose their jobs during a recession.
